Government's Fiscal Balance Report: The First 5 Months of Fiscal Year 2019 (October 2018 – February 2019)

Mr. Lavaron Sangsanit, Director–General of the Fiscal Policy Office and Ministry of Finance's Spokesperson stated that in the first 5 months of fiscal year 2019 (October 2018 – February 2019), the government has received 978,096 million baht in revenue. The government budget disbursement was at 1,468,819 million baht. To finance such deficit, the government has borrowed 217,778 million baht. Therefore, the treasury reserve at the end of February 2019 was at 325,602 million baht.
