Government's Fiscal Balance Report: The First 4 months of Fiscal Year 2018

Ms. Kulaya Tantitemit, Inspector General of Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Finance's Spokesman, announced the government fiscal balance for the first 4 months of fiscal year 2018 (October 2017 - January 2018). The government has received 737,260 million baht in revenue. The government budget disbursement was at 1,212,023 million baht. To finance such deficit, the government has borrowed 191,351 million baht. Therefore, the treasury reserve at the end of January 2018 was at 188,735 million baht.

Ms. Kulaya concluded, "Fiscal balance in the first 4 months of fiscal year 2018 remained strong. The government will ensure that budget disbursement acceleration which will support Thai economy to grow at targeted rate."
